#### Course outline

The Foundations of Chronic Disease course aims to provide students with foundation knowledge and has been designed for professionals new to the field of chronic disease management.

The course explores a range of topics including the burden of chronic disease globally and locally, understanding the patient journey and communication styles to enhance health literacy, understanding the use and appropriateness of prevention and prevention tools, identifying readiness for change and health behaviours, and the role of health data to inform service delivery.

#### Course outcome

Upon successful completion of the course students should have the ability to:

- Understand the definition and burden of chronic disease
- Understand the influencing factors on health
- Identify modifiable and non-modifiable risk factors
- Understand the patient journey and link to coordinated care, cultural safety, health literacy, and communication styles
- Identify the need for prevention and the use of prevention tools
- Understand the role of primary healthcare in care coordination and chronic disease management

#### Course content

Fully online course consisting of blended learning including knowledge information, articles, learning videos and self reflection activities.

The course includes detailed information on the determinants of health, Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander health, chronic disease frameworks, the patient journey, health literacy, and chronic conditions.
