Course outline

This course outlines the competencies and understanding necessary for executing CPR in accordance with the guidelines set by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC).

Participants will acquire the knowledge and assurance needed to perform CPR on adults, children, and infants.

The course covers essential topics such as the DRSABCD action plan and appropriate responses to emergency situations, handling unconscious casualties, performing CPR, and utilising a defibrillator (AED).

Course outcome

No prerequisites are necessary for the CPR course, but participants must possess a basic level of literacy and numeracy for course admission.

It is mandatory to perform at least 2 minutes of uninterrupted single rescuer CPR on an adult resuscitation manikin placed on the floor as part of the course requirements.
