Course outcome

On completion of this course the student will be able to:

- Identify and obtain clinical and personal relevant data for blood collection
- Choose the appropriate equipment for blood collection
- Perform the blood collection procedure
- Discuss the considerations that influence the correct selection of blood collection equipment including size and type of needle and collection site
- Perform post blood collection procedures including patient care, documentation and follow up
- Trouble shoot problems
- Discuss and manage possible complications

Course content

The Perform Blood Collection Course will enable participants to enhance their ability to successfully perform venous blood collections using the evacuated system, winged infusion sets (butterfly needles), and the needle and syringe collection methods.

Course structure

To achieve competency in this course, students must successfully:

- Perform 20 blood collections in a workplace environment of which 10 must be via the evacuated system during a period of at least 35 hours under the supervision of a person currently working in a phlebotomist role for at least 18 hours per fortnight

Workplace-observed practice is mandatory.

All workplace activities must be completed in accordance with work health and safety standards and all other relevant workplace policies and procedures.

The minimum cost for group delivery is \$4,500.

Please note, closed footwear is required for the workshop.
